EXECUTIVE ORDER 95-19

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the power vested in me by the provisions of Section 8-122 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes hereby order that, pursuant to the Judgment entered on April 21, 1995, in Roger County by District Judge Dynda Post finding that it was impossible to determine to whom a certificate of election should be issued, a new Town of Oologah Municipal General Election for Town Clerk shall be held on July 11, 1995.

The Secretary of the State Election Board and the Secretary of the Rogers County Election Board are hereby directed to take all actions necessary to conduct this election.

Copies of this Executive Order shall be distributed to the Secretary of the State Election Board and the Secretary of the Rogers County Election Board.
