EXECUTIVE ORDER 95-27

WHEREAS, Homer F. Rieger served the citizens of Enid, Oklahoma as a member of the City Council from 1971 to 1975; and

WHEREAS, Homer F. Rieger served in the Oklahoma House of Representatives with distinction from 1978 through 1988, representing the citizens of District 40; and

WHEREAS, Homer F. Rieger was well respected by his fellow legislators and the many staff and state employees which he worked with throughout his legislative career; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma lost one of its finest citizens, Homer F. Rieger, on August 7, 1995

NOW, THEREFORE, I Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, hereby direct the appropriate steps be taken to fly all American flags on State property at half staff from the date of this order until 5:00 p.m. on August 11, 1995.

This Executive Order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Department of Central Services who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
