EXECUTIVE ORDER 96-1

TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE AND
THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA

I, Frank Keating, Governor of Oklahoma, pursuant to the powers vested in me by Section 27 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution, hereby amend Executive Order 95-17 which called the Oklahoma Legislature into Special Session.

Pursuant to the authority granted and procedures provided in Section 23 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, the Special Session shall also consider a special appropriation from the Constitutional Reserve Fund. The special appropriation shall be for the purposes of providing funds to agencies in danger of ceasing operations as a result of the temporary absence of federal funding. Such funding is to be limited to providing funds until there is a final federal budget resolution.

Copies of this Executive Order shall immediately be distributed to the Lieutenant Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Director of the Office of State Finance.
