EXECUTIVE ORDER 96-11

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, hereby direct the appropriate steps be taken to fly all American flags on State property at half staff from this date until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 22, 1996 to honor State Representative Bill Widener, who died on Saturday, March 16, at the age of 56.

Widener was an outstanding member of his community and his dedication to Oklahoma as a public servant representing Blaine, Custer, and Dewey counties will be sadly missed. Widener was the Majority Whip of the State House of Representatives and was completing his eighth consecutive two-year term.

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Department of Central Services who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
