EXECUTIVE ORDER 96-21

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma and the provisions of Section 13-111 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes proclaim that the charter amendments to Article IV, Section 5, Article VI, Section 5, Article X, Section 8.2, Article X, Section 8.3, Article XI, Section 3, and Article XII, Section 13 of the Charter of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, submitted to the vote on February 13, 1996, have been duly adopted pursuant to the laws of Oklahoma.

Therefore, I find that the amendments are not in conflict with the Constitution or laws of the State of Oklahoma and hereby approve the adopted amendments to be in full force and effect as provided by law.

A copy of this executive order shall be forwarded to Mayor of the City of Tulsa.
