EXECUTIVE ORDER 96-33

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, hereby direct the appropriate steps be taken to fly all American flags on State property at half staff until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 30, 1996, to honor former Representative Lewis Melvin Kamas who died on October 26, 1996 at the age of 75.

Representative Kamas served in the U.S. Army Signal Corps and U.S. Army Air Force in World War II. He entered his service in politics as a Republican member of the 31st Legislature in 1967 and served until 1988. During his service as a member of the House of Representatives, he served as secretary of the Republican Caucus, Minority Whip and Assistant Minority Floor Leader.

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Department of Central Services who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
