EXECUTIVE ORDER 96-34

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, hereby direct the appropriate steps be taken to fly all American flags on State property at half staff until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 20, 1996, to honor former Oklahoma State Public Safety Commissioner Paul W. Reed, who died on Friday, November 15, 1996.

Reed, a Sulphur native, was Public Safety Commissioner from 1979 to 1987. Reed served as District Attorney in Murray County from 1967 to 1978 and was a retired brigadier general. I join our fellow Oklahomans in expressing our deepest sympathy to the Reed family.

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Department of Central Services who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
