EXECUTIVE ORDER 97-04

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Executive Branch Reform Act of 1986, hereby transfer the Wildlife Conservation Commission and Department of Wildlife Conservation from the responsibility of the Secretary for the Department of Environment to the responsibility of the Secretary for the Department of Tourism and Recreation.

This modification of the Cabinet areas established in Executive Order 95-8 on April 7, 1995, is to be considered an amendment to that order.

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Secretary of the Department of Environment and the Secretary of the Department of Tourism and Recreation who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented.
