**EXECUTIVE ORDER 98-28**  
(Corrected Copy)

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I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Sections 1 and 2 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution, hereby establish an Oklahoma Year 2000 Task Force.

Due to automated integration throughout the world's economy, virtually every aspect of daily life is dependent upon the successful operation of computers and electronic equipment. In view of the potential for the failure of society to meet Y2K compliance deadlines or the failure of systems that provide services to citizens of this state, it is necessary to develop contingency plans to reduce the impact of possible loss of services.

The Y2K Task Force shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

To identify and document potential problems with the computer systems and other electronic equipment of the State;

To research alternatives and recommend solutions to potential problems;

To develop contingency plans for continued operations;

To recommend funding options structured with the objective of establishing a fallback position on the part of government to maintain law and control in the midst of potential service disruption;

To establish deadlines that insure satisfactory progress and to report to the Governor all instances of failure to meet these deadlines;

To establish reporting requirements;

To insure that all plans and implementation schedules are documented and in place by December 31, 1999.

The total membership of the Y2K Task Force shall consist of 21 voting members. The Chairman and Vice Chairman of the task force shall be members of the task force who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor. Membership of the Board shall be composed of the following members:


- Chairman -- Adjutant General Steve Cortright
- Vice Chairman -- State Comptroller Keith Johnson
- The Oklahoma State Treasurer
- The Oklahoma Attorney General
- The Commissioner of Public Safety
- The Director of the Department of Human Services
- The Executive Vice Chancellor for the Regents for Higher Education
- The Information Services Director of the Office of State Finance
- The Director of the Public Utility Division of the Corporation Commission
- The Director of the Petroleum Storage Tanks Division of the Corporation Commission
- The Motor Vehicle Director of the Oklahoma Tax Commission
- The Collections Director of the Oklahoma Tax Commission
- The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Municipal League
- The Vice-President of Government Affairs of the State Chamber of Commerce
- The Executive Director of the Oklahoma State School Board Association

And such other additional members as may be appointed by the Governor.

This executive order shall be forwarded to all Cabinet members and agency directors who shall provide necessary resources as requested by the task force.
