**EXECUTIVE ORDER 99-06**

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Sections 1 and 2 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution and Section 840--2.20A of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes do hereby appoint the Secretary of Safety and Security to serve as my designee for authorizing agencies or parts of agencies to maintain minimum services when hazardous weather becomes a safety threat, causes undue delays or prohibits employees from traveling to and from work.

Those employees authorized to be absent from work due to these conditions shall be governed by the appropriate administrative rules of the Office of Personnel Management concerning options available to account for lost time.

This Executive Order shall be forwarded to the Secretary for Safety and Security, the Secretary of Administration and the Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government. Copies of this Executive Order shall be supplied to each Cabinet Secretary.
