EXECUTIVE ORDER 99-13

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma hereby direct the appropriate steps be taken to fly all American and Oklahoma flags on State property at half staff from 8:00 a.m. Saturday, May 1, 1999 until 8:00 a.m. Monday, May 3, 1999, in recognition of Oklahoma Correctional Officers Week.

The State of Oklahoma is proud of the men and women who work as correctional officers in both the public and private sector. These officers work long, often thankless hours to ensure both the safety of the public from those who violate the law, and the security of the inmates while serving their punishment. The people of Oklahoma are extremely grateful to these officers who often risk their own safety in the performance of their job. The State of Oklahoma salutes them all.

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of Central Services who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
