EXECUTIVE ORDER 99-29

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma hereby direct the appropriate steps be taken to fly all American and Oklahoma flags on State property at half staff from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 30, 1999 to honor John Crews who died Saturday, September 25, 1999.

Mr. Crews was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor for heroism during the Battle of the Bulge in World War II. Crews remained active in the Medal of Honor Society and 63rd Division where he was inducted into the Military Hall of Fame.

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of Central Services who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
