Americans across the nation are united in calling upon God to bring comfort and healing to the victims, their families, and to the El Paso and Dayton communities, and justice to all those impacted by these tragic events.


This executive order shall be forwarded to the Division of Capital Assets Management who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
