EXECUTIVE ORDER 2010-11

I, Brad Henry, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, hereby direct the appropriate steps be taken to fly all American and Oklahoma flags on State property at half-staff from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 15, 2010, to honor Bill S. Cole, an Oklahoma resident, who died on Wednesday, March 10, 2010, at age 72.

Dr. Cole served as President of East Central University from 1989 until his retirement in 2006. Prior to that, President Cole served as the President of El Reno Junior College, now Redlands Community College. President Cole was a dedicated public servant and a faithful representative to his constituents. Throughout his life, President Cole made great contributions to the State of Oklahoma.

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of Central Services who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
