EXECUTIVE ORDER 2010-25

I, Brad Henry, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, hereby direct the appropriate steps be taken to fly all American and Oklahoma flags on State property at half-staff from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 28, 2010, to honor former State Representative Mina Hibdon, an Oklahoma resident, who died on Saturday, May 21, 2010, at age 83.

Representative Hibdon served in the Oklahoma State House of Representatives from 1973 to 1976. Representative Hibdon was a dedicated public servant and a faithful representative to her constituents. Throughout her life, Representative Hibdon made great contributions to the State of Oklahoma.


This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of Central Services who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
