EXECUTIVE PROCLAMATION**

I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 121 through 132 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes, hereby authorize a referendum on the question of whether a majority of the employees of Caddo Public School District (I-005), of Bryan County, Oklahoma, desire full Social Security coverage, as provided by the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (FICA) tax.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 121 through 132 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes and Section 218 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. § 418), I hereby authorize that a referendum of employees be held by Caddo Public School District (I-005) of Bryan County, Oklahoma, on or after August 5, 2013, said date being not less than 90 days hence. The Department of Human Services, Division of Finance, State Bureau of Social Security, has been designated to supervise the referendum for eligible employees of said school district to ascertain if such employees desire full coverage of Social Security benefits as provided by State and Federal law.


Dear Governor Fallin,


By statute an election date will be set to allow a ninety day notice of the referendum and all eligible employees will be given the opportunity to vote.
