EXECUTIVE PROCLAMATION**

I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the provisions of Section 12-111 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes, hereby order Mr. Bill Phillips to fill the vacancy in the office of County Commissioner for District 1 of McIntosh County, Oklahoma. The vacancy exists due to the resignation of the Honorable Bobby James, County Commissioner for District 1 of McIntosh County, Oklahoma.


