I was appointed by Governor Brad Henry and began my service on the Supreme Court on January 1, 2011. In the general election of 2012, I was retained as Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma, Supreme Court Judicial District No. 8.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Constitution, art. 7 and 7-B, and 26 O.S. 2011 §§11-101 and 11-106, I hereby declare that I am a candidate for retention in the office as Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court from the 8th Judicial District, or office No. 8, in the upcoming general election.

I will appreciate your advising the Secretary of the State Election Board of this declaration, and I request that my name be placed on the retention ballot for the November General Election in compliance with 26 O.S. 2011 §11-109.


