Dear Secretary Bengé,

Please accept this letter in compliance and pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Constitution, Article VII-B, § 5, in that I am herewith giving notice of my desire to seek retention in office at the next General Election (November 8, 2016).

As your records will reflect, I was appointed by the Honorable Mary Fallin, Governor of the Great State of Oklahoma, as evidenced by that "Order of Appointment" filed with your Office on March 11, the year 2015. I have therefore served more than twelve (12) months in office since my appointment, and pursuant to the provisions of Title 26, Oklahoma Statutes, 2011, § 11-102, I am required to file a Declaration of Candidacy with your office not less than sixty (60) days before the date of the next General Election following my appointment in order to be retained in office.

Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of Articles VII and VII-B of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma, and pursuant to Title 26 Oklahoma Statutes 2011, § 11-101 et seq., I hereby humbly and respectfully declare that I am a candidate for retention in office as Judge of the Court of Criminal Appeals, Judicial District No. 2. I further request that notification be given by your Office to the State Election Board Secretary so I will be listed on the retention ballot required by 26 O.S.2011, § 11-109, for the next General Election.

Finally, I respectfully request that I be listed on the retention ballot as **Robert L. Hudson**. Thank you.


