WHEREAS, the Fort Sill Apache Tribe ("Tribe") is a federally recognized Tribe with a Constitution and Bylaws (Constitution) approved by the U.S. Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Sill Apache Business Committee is authorized to act for the Tribe in accordance with Article IV of the Fort Sill Apache Constitution and By-Laws; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has a cross-deputization agreement with the State of Oklahoma through which city, county and tribal agencies can choose to join that agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Business Committee finds it to be in the best interest of the tribe and its members to support the Bureau of Indian Affairs efforts to enter into a cross-deputization agreement with Apache Police Department of Apache, OK; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Fort Sill Apache Business Committee hereby supports a cross-deputization agreement between the Bureau of Indian Affairs and Apache Police Department of Apache, Oklahoma for the provision of law enforcement within the tribe's Indian country as defined in 18 U.S.C. 1151.
