An Act relating to the Department of Rehabilitation Services; making an appropriation to the Department of Rehabilitation Services; stating purpose; making appropriations nonfiscal; making appropriations exempt from certain agency category and budget limits; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Rehabilitation Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Department of Rehabilitation Services by law.

SECTION 2. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the fiscal years 2010 and 2011 agency category and budget limits.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.


