An Act relating to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations; directing transfer of certain funds; stating amount; making an appropriation; stating purpose; amending Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1246 of the 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to budgetary categories and limits; modifying certain budgetary limits; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. TRANSFER The Director of the Office of State Finance shall transfer the sum of Two Hundred Thirty-three Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-nine Dollars (\$233,469.00) from the Drug Money Laundering and Wire Transmitter Revolving Fund ("220 Fund") of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control to the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Two Hundred Thirty-three Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-nine Dollars (\$233,469.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1246 of the 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Board of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.




