An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society;
making an appropriation; defining purpose; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Two Hundred Ninety-two Thousand Eight Hundred Six Dollars (\$292,806.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
