An Act relating to public safety; requiring branding of certain vehicle titles; directing law enforcement to notify Oklahoma Tax Commission; providing terms to appear on title; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-503A of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:


Any law enforcement agency in this state that seizes a vehicle in which a controlled dangerous substance has been manufactured that is forfeited pursuant to Section 2-503 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes may request that the Oklahoma Tax Commission brand the certificate of title with the notation "Drug Manufacture Vehicle".

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.




