An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Department of Health; authorizing the Department to contract with vendor for electronic benefit transfer for certain program; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Oklahoma State Department of Health is authorized to contract with an existing vendor providing electronic benefit transfer system capability to the Department of Human Services for the purpose of delivering Women, Infants and Children (WIC) benefits electronically.


SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.




