An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating the Tribal Elder Parrish Williams Memorial Highway; designating the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Parkway; designating the Marcus Eugene Mills Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.74 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

That portion of State Highway 177 from White Eagle Road extending south to Eagles Nest Road shall be designated as "Tribal Elder Parrish Williams Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.75 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

That portion of U.S. Highway 77 from the junction of U.S. Highway 77 and South Avenue in Ponca City extending south to the junction of U.S. Highway 77 and East Harding Road shall be

designated as "Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Parkway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.76 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge on State Highway 3E approximately one and one-half (1.5) miles south of Bowlegs shall be designated as the "Marcus Eugene Mills Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing that name.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
