A Concurrent Resolution recognizing the 75th anniversary of the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS); commending the NRCS for its work and service in Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Dust Bowl of the 1930's had a devastating impact on Oklahoma, shaping its people, economy and natural resources policy; and

WHEREAS, through the Dust Bowl experience, the people of Oklahoma came to understand what can happen if the precious natural resources of our state are not conserved and protected; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma in partnership with the federal government and local landowners undertook programs designed to conserve the natural resources of the state through voluntary,

locally led means that respected private property rights while protecting natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the year 2010 marks the 75th anniversary of the formation of the United States Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service, formerly the Soil Conservation Service, which is the means through which the federal government has undertaken partnerships with farmers, ranchers and other landowners to provide technical guidance and financial assistance to protect our soil, water, air and wildlife habitats; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma is indebted to the Natural Resources Conservation Service and the people who have worked for the Service over the past 75 years for the work done to improve our environment and would like to recognize and to pay tribute to their contributions to our state.


