A Resolution proclaiming April 24, 2010, Kelsey Briggs Day.

WHEREAS, the death of two-year-old Kelsey Briggs on October 11, 2005, brought to national attention the heartbreaking reality of child abuse in our country and its tragic consequences; and

WHEREAS, Kelsey's story has inspired many in the crusade to prevent child abuse; and

WHEREAS, the first annual Kelsey Briggs Day was held on April 29, 2006, in honor of Kelsey's memory and to raise awareness of child abuse prevention; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of Kelsey Briggs Day is to share Kelsey's story and distribute child abuse prevention information, including materials about hotlines, shelters, and local agencies that can help, and how to recognize signs of abuse; and

WHEREAS, the fifth annual Kelsey Briggs Day will be held on April 24, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
