An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
designating the Veterans Memorial Highway in
Blanchard; providing for codification; and declaring
an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.60 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 62 beginning and ending with the
city limits of Blanchard shall be designated as the "Veterans
Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing
that name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
