A Joint Resolution relating to ballot measures; stating that the Secretary of State shall not refer certain proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma as set forth in Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1041 of the 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature; directing filing; and providing a conditional effective date.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall not refer to the people for their approval or rejection the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma, amending Section 1 of Article VII, as set forth in Section 1 of Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1041 of the 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of the Senate, immediately after the passage of this resolution, shall prepare and file one copy thereof with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney General.


SECTION 3. The provisions of this resolution shall not become effective as law unless Enrolled House Bill No. 2652 of the 2nd Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature becomes effective as law.




