ENROLLED HOUSE BILL NO. 1230:

This is to advise you that on this date, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 11 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution to approve or object to legislation presented to me, I have VETOED House Bill 1230.

This bill would change the current restriction that no person shall be eligible to be a motor license agent if they are related to an Oklahoma Legislator or employee of the Oklahoma Tax Commission within the third degree of consanguinity or affinity to second degree of consanguinity or affinity. This change would weaken the law designed to prevent appointments arising from nepotism instead of merit.
