An Act relating to the Physician Manpower Training Commission; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 697.7, which relates to the Hospital Residency Revolving Fund; deleting authorization for certain hospital agreements; modifying source of payments to the Fund; and modifying name of the Fund.

SUBJECT: Physician Manpower Training Commission

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 697.7, is amended to read as follows:


Section 697.7 The Physician Manpower Training Commission is hereby authorized to enter into contractual arrangements with ~~any qualified hospital in any city or town in Oklahoma whereby the hospital would accommodate a resident physician to practice in the hospital during a six-month elective phase of the residency training program which is conducted in an accredited free standing teaching hospital in cooperation with programs at the University of Oklahoma College of Medicine, University of Oklahoma-Tulsa Medical College, and or the Oklahoma College of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery, in order to enhance available funding for the training of primary care residents and.~~ The hospital accommodating said resident physician shall pay to the Commission such monies as may be required to cover the agreed amount to pay the cost of the salary stipend and expenses of the resident physician for the period of time spent in practice

at ~~said hospital~~ the residency programs. Monies received by the Commission from the participating ~~hospital~~ residency training program under the provisions of this section shall be deposited to, and disbursed from, the "~~Hospital~~ Residency Revolving Fund" hereby created in the State Treasury. The fund shall be a continuing fund not subject to legislative appropriation or fiscal year limitations. Expenditures from ~~said~~ the fund shall be made on warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed by the Commission with the Director of the Office of State Finance for approval and payment.


