—An Act relating to the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics; making an appropriation to the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics; stating purpose; requiring expenditure of certain sum for certain purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring performance measures; making certain students eligible for certain programs; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain years; providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Appropriation to the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School for Science and Mathematics

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law.

SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act and Section 35 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2170 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Four Hundred

Seventy-seven Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-one Dollars (\$1,477,331.00) shall be expended for the purpose of developing and offering pilot outreach programs in science and mathematics as directed in Section 1210.404 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The Board of Trustees shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget category.

SECTION 4. Students who are enrolled in a consolidated school district shall be eligible to apply to attend regional pilot outreach programs in science and mathematics as directed in Section 1210.404 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes if all or part of the consolidated school district is served by the technology center school district.

SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act and Section 35 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2170 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013 (hereafter FY-13). Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2012, and must be expended by November 15, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, and not budgeted for FY-13, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-13 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2013. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2013, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-12, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be

budgeted for FY-13, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-12 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.


