A Resolution congratulating Dan Bailey, Oklahoma State University Cowboy football player and 2010 Lou Groza Award winner; wishing him well in future endeavors; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, 2010 was an outstanding year for Dan Bailey, the 6-foot, 197-pound Senior kicker for the Oklahoma State University football team, a year that will figure prominently in the record

book for both its star kicker and for the entire Cowboy football team; and

WHEREAS, in 2010 Dan Bailey was named the Lou Groza Award winner as the top college football kicker in the nation; was named the Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Year; was number two in the nation in scoring as a senior with 11.6 points per game; and ended his career as the fifth leading scorer in Big 12 history; and

WHEREAS, Dan Bailey has set many Oklahoma State University football records including 27 field goals in the 2010 season; hitting his first 182 extra-point attempts; three of the top 16 scoring seasons as a kicker in the history of Oklahoma State University football with 149 points in the 2010 season to rank second, 110 points in the 2008 season to rank fifth, and 85 points in the 2009 season to rank 16th; all-time most conversions and consecutive conversions; and

WHEREAS, Dan Bailey entered the Oklahoma State University football program as a walk-on player and leaves as the all-time leading scorer with 370 career points; and


