At the age of fourteen, Emoly began teaching dance and through the years has influenced hundreds of children in the arts. One of Emoly's favorite activities with her students is "Dancing With Character", where she incorporates a specific character trait into each dance lesson; and

WHEREAS, Emoly West graduated high school with honors in 2004 and was selected by her peers to deliver the student speech at their Home School Class of 2004 Oklahoma Christian Home-School Educators Consociation graduation. She attended Oklahoma Christian University from 2004 to 2007. While at Oklahoma Christian she was active in student government, was Chair of the Presidential Student Ambassadors and received several scholarships. In the fall of 2006, Emoly was selected to study abroad throughout the Pacific Rim as an international student. At UCO, Emoly is a member of the Kaleidoscope Dance Company, Gamma Beta Phi National Honor Society, Alpha Chi National Honor Society, and a recipient of a Department of Dance scholarship; and
