An Act relating to the Oklahoma Energy Independence Act; amending Section 1, Chapter 71, O.S.L. 2010 (19 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 460.2a), which relates to the County Energy District Authority; modifying membership of authority; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: County Energy District Authority shall consist of the Circuit Engineering District Board of Directors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 71, O.S.L. 2010 (19 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 460.2a), is amended to read as follows:

Section 460.2a. A. The board of directors of a circuit engineering district, established pursuant to Section 687.1 et seq. of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, may by resolution, establish a County Energy District Authority pursuant to the provisions of ~~this act~~ the Oklahoma Energy Independence Act, for the district. The authority shall be a public trust as provided for in Sections 176 through 180.3 of Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. The authority shall consist of ~~five (5) trustees as follows:~~ the Circuit Engineering District Board of Directors.


~~1. Three members of the board of directors of the circuit engineering district; and~~

~~2. Two persons appointed by the board of directors of the circuit engineering district. The appointed members shall be residents of the district and shall not be elected officials.~~

C. The chair of the board of directors of the circuit engineering district shall serve as chair of the authority.


SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
