An Act relating to the State Fire Marshal; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 320, which relates to prohibitions on the State Fire Marshal; prohibiting the State Fire Marshal from engaging in business that is a conflict of interest; providing statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: State Fire Marshal

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 320, is amended to read as follows:

Section 320. The State Fire Marshal shall not engage in any other business and he and his assistant that may be a conflict of interest with duties of the State Fire Marshal. The State Fire Marshal and the Assistant State Fire Marshal shall at all times be ready for such duties as are required by this act Sections 314 through 326.11 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
