An Act relating to the University Hospitals Authority; requiring transfers of certain funds; requiring certain funds be used for certain programs; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: University Hospitals Authority

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. TRANSFER The University Hospitals Authority shall transfer the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) from the funds appropriated in Section 81 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2170 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature to the University Hospitals Authority Disbursing Fund created by Section 3221 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to be expended in accordance with law.

SECTION 2. TRANSFER The University Hospitals Authority shall transfer the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) from the funds appropriated in Section 81 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2170 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature to the Oklahoma Institute for Disaster and Emergency Medicine Revolving Fund established pursuant to Section 1-2523 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to be expended in accordance with law.


SECTION 3. TRANSFER The University Hospitals Authority shall transfer the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$375,000.00) from the funds appropriated in Section 81 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2170 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature to the Dental Loan Repayment Revolving Fund established pursuant to Section 1-2714 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to be expended in accordance with law.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the University Hospitals Authority in Section 81 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2170 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature, One Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Dollars (\$178,000.00) shall be used for providing hearing services for deaf and/or hard of hearing children statewide.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.


SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
