WHEREAS, the University of Oklahoma Sooners football team, under
Coach Bob Stoops, won the Big 12 Championship for the seventh time
in the last eleven years, and won the 40th Tostitos Fiesta Bowl in a
48-20 victory over Connecticut; and

WHEREAS, the Sooners won ten or more games per season for an
NCAA record thirty-two times and the Sooners became only the seventh
program in college football history to win 800 games; and

WHEREAS, the Sooners extended the nation's longest-active-home
winning streak to thirty-six games; and

WHEREAS, the Sooners produced two consensus All-Americans in Ryan Broyles and Quinton Carter to run the school's all-time total to 152; and

WHEREAS, the Sooners produced the Sammy Baugh Award winner in Landry Jones; and

WHEREAS, Quinton Carter won the Wooden Citizenship Cup and is one of the eleven players named to the American Football Coaches Association Good Works Team; and

WHEREAS, the Sooners produced an Academic All-American in Brian Lepak.


