WHEREAS, the 2010-2011 Snyder High School Girls Basketball Team
won the Class 2A State Basketball Championship with a 53-49 victory
over the top-ranked Millwood Lady Falcons at the State Fair Arena in
Oklahoma City; and

WHEREAS, the Lady Cyclones, under head coach Jeremy Tharp, took
the lead early on in the game by keeping the Millwood Lady Falcons
from scoring for more than three minutes during the start of the
game. At the start of the fourth quarter the Lady Cyclones trailed

by three points, but they never gave up. The Snyder Lady Cyclones proved victorious, and brought the Gold Ball Trophy home to Snyder for the first time in school history; and

WHEREAS, the Snyder Lady Cyclones also won the district and regional championships and the area consolation championship. They also placed second in both the Chattanooga Invitational and the Tri-County Tournament, and won the championship in the Farmers Bank Classic and were the Shortgrass Conference Champions; and

WHEREAS, the Lady Cyclones record-making season is a source of great honor and pride for Snyder High School, for the people of Snyder, and for all citizens of Oklahoma, where the Lady Cyclones are state champions.
