An Act relating to state government; authorizing contracts with third-party vendor to conduct employment screenings, background and credit checks; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Government contracts with third-party vendor to conduct employment screenings, background and credit checks

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10001 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any agency, board, commission, higher education institution, career technology or common education institution may contract with a third-party vendor who is a member in good standing with the National Association of Professional Background Screeners to perform any and all employment screenings, background checks and credit checks.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
