regarding furlough; prescribing content of notice;
and providing for codification.

SUBJECT: Furlough of state employees

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.20C of Title 74, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:


Each agency, as defined by Section 840-1.3 of Title 74 of the
Oklahoma Statutes, shall provide a written notice to any employee of
such agency who will be furloughed by the agency at least thirty
(30) days prior to the first date that the furlough period is
scheduled to begin. The notice shall provide information about the
anticipated first date of the furlough period and an estimate of the
duration of the furlough or the day or days during which the
furlough will be in effect.


