An Act relating to the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists; permitting the chair of the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists to conduct certain hearings in specified circumstances; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: State Board of Examiners of Psychologists

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1370.2 of Title 59, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The chair of the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists, upon concurrence of the vice-chair of the Board that an emergency exists for which the immediate suspension of a license is imperative for the public health, safety, and welfare, may conduct a hearing as provided by Section 314 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes to temporarily suspend the license of any person under the jurisdiction of the Board.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
