An Act relating to county purchasing; amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 1723, which relates to competitive bidding; removing requirement for certain competitive bidding; requiring board of trustees of any emergency medical service district to utilize certain bidding requirements for all purchases; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: County entity purchasing procedures

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:


SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 1723, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1723. Purchases by any board ~~which are in excess of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), or in the case of written or facsimile quotes, purchases in excess of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00),~~ of trustees of any emergency medical service district shall be by competitive bid made in accordance with the bidding requirements as provided in Sections 1501 and 1505 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.


SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
