
SUBJECT: Durable power of attorney

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. REPEALER 58 O.S. 2011, Section 1074, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 315, O.S.L. 2010, is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.


