An Act relating to the Feral Swine Control Act; amending 2 O.S. 2011, Sections 6-608 and 6-609, which relate to feral swine; modifying importation requirements for live feral swine; modifying transport destinations of live feral swine; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Feral Swine Control Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-608, is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-608. A. ~~Any~~ No person ~~importing~~ shall import live feral swine into this state ~~shall be unless the live feral swine are going directly to a slaughter facility in a sealed trailer and accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian that contains the following:~~

- ~~1. A written entry permit approved by the State Veterinarian or chief animal health official of the state of origin;~~
- ~~2. Individual identification of each feral swine; and~~
- ~~3. Negative brucellosis and pseudorabies test results USDA vs 1-27 permit for the movement of restricted animals.~~

~~B. A person shall obtain a negative brucellosis and pseudorabies test within fifteen (15) days prior to entry.~~

~~C. All live feral swine imported into this state shall be quarantined and isolated to retest for brucellosis and pseudorabies. The testing shall be conducted no earlier than thirty (30) days and no later than sixty (60) days following the date of importation, except for feral swine going directly to an approved slaughter facility.~~

~~D. All feral swine in this state that test positive for brucellosis or pseudorabies shall be immediately sent directly to slaughter or slaughtered on the premises pursuant to an order issued by the State Veterinarian.~~

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-609, is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-609. A. The State Board of Agriculture shall promulgate rules for the testing and intrastate movement of live feral swine.

B. All persons that transport live feral swine in this state shall be required to obtain a transporter license from the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry.

C. Live feral swine shall only be transported to the following:

1. A licensed sporting facility;
2. A licensed ~~breeding~~ handling facility;
3. ~~A licensed buying station;~~
4. ~~A licensed gathering station;~~
5. Directly to an approved ~~market or~~ slaughter facility; or
6. 4. Pursuant to an order issued by the State Veterinarian.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
