An Act relating to disaster areas; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1213, which relates to penalties; modifying certain penalties; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Disaster area criminal penalties

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1213, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1213. ~~(a)~~ 1. It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provisions of ~~this act~~ Section 1209 et seq. of this title.


~~(b)~~ 2. Every person convicted of a misdemeanor for violating any provision of ~~this act~~ Section 1209 et seq. of this title shall be punished by a fine of not ~~less than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)~~ Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) or by imprisonment for not more than ~~ten (10) days~~ one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.


