An Act relating to the Department of Corrections;
requiring certain funds be used for certain purposes;
requiring certain spending level; and authorizing
expenditure of certain funds.

SUBJECT: Department of Corrections

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of Corrections in Sections 144 and 145 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1975 of the 2nd Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature, Two Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,900,000.00) shall be used for security enhancements, population reduction and renovation at the Oklahoma State Penitentiary.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the Department of Corrections shall spend an amount equal to what it spent on private prisons and halfway houses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, plus an additional Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00).

SECTION 3. The Department of Corrections is hereby authorized to expend from the Industries Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 541 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum of One Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,250,000.00) or so

much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Corrections by law.
