An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
requiring and authorizing certain expenditures;
requiring and authorizing certain transfers of funds;
authorizing Patrol Academy; reappropriating certain
funds; providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

SUBJECT: Department of Public Safety

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of Public Safety by Section 110 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Twenty-six Thousand Dollars (\$26,000.00) shall be expended for the services of a Capitol Patrol Officer to the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court pursuant to a contract between the Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court.

SECTION 2. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of Public Safety by Section 110 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) shall be expended for the annual lease payment of the Clinton/Sherman Industrial Complex.

SECTION 3. The Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized to expend Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) from the Department of Public Safety Patrol Vehicle Revolving Fund for the fiscal year

ending June 30, 2014, for the purchase of patrol vehicles and aircraft and equipping those vehicles and aircraft, as well as other operational expenses of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol.

SECTION 4. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of Public Safety by Section 110 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) shall be transferred to the Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy Revolving Fund created by Section 2-146 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 5. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of Public Safety by Section 110 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Three Hundred Eight Thousand Two Hundred Forty-six Dollars (\$308,246.00) shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Climatological Survey, under the direction and supervision of the Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma, for the use of the Survey to perform its duties as prescribed by law.

SECTION 6. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of Public Safety by Section 110 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2301 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, Nine Hundred thirty-five Thousand Eight Hundred One Dollars (\$935,801.00) shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security. Of the funds transferred herein, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is authorized for transfer to the Oklahoma Homeland Security Revolving Fund created by Section 51.2 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 7. The Department of Public Safety, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, is authorized to have one (1) Patrol Academy consisting of no fewer than thirty (30) cadets.

SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION The amount of One Million One Hundred Ninety-five Thousand One Hundred Forty-five Dollars (\$1,195,145.00) of the original appropriation of Ninety-eight Million Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-one Dollars (\$98,370,391.00) appropriated to the Department of Public Safety by Section 119, Chapter 317, O.S.L. 2007, from monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Public Safety by law, is hereby reappropriated for the purpose of construction of a new Troop K Headquarters. If, on the date this act is approved, any of the

amount originally appropriated, as adjusted by expenditures, encumbrances and transfers, results in an unencumbered balance less than the reappropriated amount, that reappropriated amount is reduced to the unencumbered amount.

SECTION 9. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.




