An Act relating to transportation of deceased persons; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 101, which relates to issuance of burial-transit permits; requiring burial transit permits to be issued by the Chief Medical Examiner; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Transportation of deceased persons

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 101, is amended to read as follows:

Section 101. No railroad or other common carrier shall receive for shipment to any point within the state or to any point outside the state the body of a deceased person unless there is attached to the shipping case, in a strong envelope, a burial-transit permit duly issued and signed by the ~~local registrar of the district in which the death occurred or the body was found~~ Chief Medical Examiner.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
